**Notice to Parents/Guardians**

Marshfield Cricket Club will take all reasonable precautions to ensure your child can enjoy playing cricket in a safe environment and subscribes to the ECB 'In Safe Hands' policy. To help the Club your attention is drawn to the following: -

1. To be covered by the Club's insurance policies, the player must be a member of Marshfield Cricket Club. There is a £20.00 membership fee.
2. All players, coaches, other helpers and parents are expected to abide by the relevant codes of conduct
3. All batsmen and the wicketkeeper when standing up to the stumps must wear a protective helmet. The Club will provide helmets but players may wish to purchase their own.
4. All batsmen and the wicketkeeper must wear a genital protector ("box"). Because of the personal nature of this item, the Club expects players to have their own box.
5. The Club wishes to be aware of any medical conditions that might apply to your child (asthma, allergies, hayfever, the taking of any medication, *etc.*). This information is important if an incident occurs that necessitates your child having emergency treatment. Please provide written information overleaf, which will be held by the Club in strict confidence.
6. The club is only responsible for the players. Parents are responsible for the behaviour and safety of accompanying, non-playing children.
7. Parents are given automatic non voting membership status as part of junior membership.
